



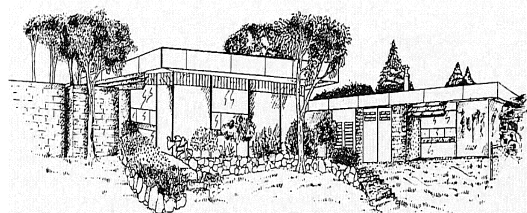

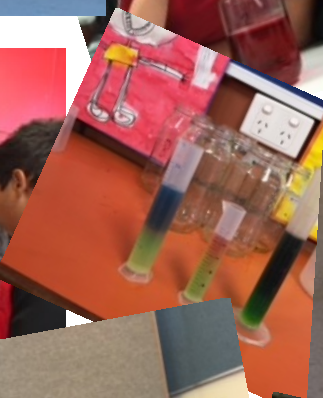

We played with the Edison technology, a robot car that scans codes and does tricks. The day was exciting and fun. The teachers and leaders had lots of fun as well. It was great seeing the smiles on everyone's faces.

Science Day was so much fun! The day before my class, the year 5/6's, allocated an egg, a jar and some vinegar to the other two classes. The students placed the egg into vinegar and the shell would come off overnight. We played with the Edison robots which you scan on a barcode. We made jelly for solids and liquids and created marshmallow sling shots. In another rotation we mixed water, food colouring and sugar to demonstrate density in water.
