



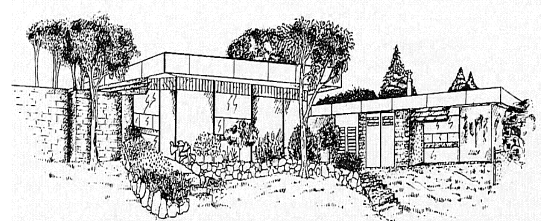

Ages and Programs

The Youth Centre is open to young people aged 10–24 years (the month they turn 10 but not earlier). Programs during school term and holidays are for 10–17 year olds.

Memberships

Program Bookings

For programs with a cost, bookings can only be made in person at the Centre.

Phone bookings can be made for programs that are free. Spaces are limited, so we recommend calling ahead and checking if spaces are available.

During the school holidays we may provide lunch; however it's best to come prepared. We have a fridge and secure lockers for storing personal belongings. Each person must be responsible for their own belongings.
