







































<p>All About Sounds Make a 3x3 Grid. Find magazine pictures from A-Z. Find all the Aa pictures put them in the 1st box, Bb in next box and so on.</p> 	<p>Picture Talk Look at an interesting picture and talk about what you see. Ask your child some questions.</p> 	<p>Sound it Out Say words slowly (c-at, s-it, f-un, h-ot, t-en). The child says it fast - cat, sit, fun, hot, ten. Find other words.</p> 	<p>Rainbow Names Write your name using coloured pencils, playdough, shaving cream, sand, paint, lego, chalk, water, bubbles.</p> 	<p>Sound Hunt Make a fairy wand and find sounds or letters in books, around the house, in the pantry, kitchen and your bedroom.</p> 
<p>Listening Game Each child has 5 blocks. One child makes a picture & describes it to the other child so the other can make the same picture.</p> 	<p>Describe and Find It Set up a model farmyard, transport, musical instruments or toy sets. Let them describe, name the animal and make the sound.</p> 	<p>1,2,3 Directions Give instructions to the child - jump two times, hop once, turn around twice, clap 3 times. Get me a pencil and book, 2 teddies. Make a sandwich, lego building, playdough creature. Ask 'left hand or right hand?'</p> 	<p>Sensory Bottle Story Select old water bottles & fill with rice or water, pebbles, marbles, shells, glitter, small toys, flower, beads, food colour, pasta, plastic animals. Shake the bottle and identify what is inside and tell a story.</p> 	<p>Find 10 Find an old bag and collect 10 things for the beach, fruits, vegetables, places to visit or garden. Ask the child to name them and what they use them for.</p> 
<p>Sound Bingo Create a 3x3 sound bingo game using pictures from an old magazine that make different sounds (Transport, Animals, Household).</p> 	<p>Can You Rhyme? Read a nursery rhyme (Hickory Dickory, Incy Wincy, Twinkle Twinkle, Humpty Dumpty) and listen for all the rhyming words.</p> 	<p>Which Am I? Find 10 objects and put them in a basket. Say a sentence to match the correct object. I am green - apple). Child finds the object.</p> 	<p>Yes or No Make up Yes/No questions (cows live on a farm, dogs bark, cats can fly). Ask the child 'Yes or No.'</p> 	<p>What Can it Do? Find 10 objects and put them in a bag. Pull out one at a time and ask them to name and describe what can it do?</p> 



<p>Number Hunt Find numbers 1-10. Count everyday objects, sing songs, count backwards, make small collections.</p> 	<p>Patterns Make repeating patterns using two colours, shapes, buttons, numbers, Lego, pop-sticks. Ask 'what comes next?'</p> 	<p>Numbers Write numbers 0-10 using sand, foam, paint, water, chalk, sand and playdough. Say 'Peggy Lego number rhymes.'</p> 	<p>Count the Dots Roll a dice and ask 'how many?' Child must say the number without counting them.</p> 	<p>Which is It? Sort objects (plastic animals, counters, toys, hats, socks) into groups. Ask 'a group of-'</p> 
<p>Long or Short Teach your child to compare lengths. Find 3 objects that are longer than a banana and shorter than a banana. Ask 'long or short?'</p> 	<p>Heavy or Light Compare the weight of everyday items. Hold an apple in one hand and place different objects in the other hand. Ask 'heavy or light?'</p> 	<p>More or Less Find a box of small blocks, counters, lego or buttons and create two groups of blocks, one with more than the other. Ask 'more or less.'</p> 	<p>Shapes or Colours Collect shapes or colours around the house, sort objects and create pictures of objects (rectangle robot). Ask 'green like grass, blue like sky.'</p> 	<p>Fill Your Container Explore the concept of which container holds more. Use clear containers of various sizes that hold the same amount. Ask 'full, empty or half full.'</p> 
<p>Position Game Locate objects and describe its position (eg: the teddy bear is on -top) Ask 'what is the position of ...?'</p> 	<p>Opposites Compare two different things (hot/cold). Match the opposites for open, happy, day, down, top, empty, on. Ask what is the opposite ?</p> 	<p>Solve a Puzzle Look in a magazine and find a favourite picture. Cut the picture in several large pieces. Make a puzzle using shapes, colour or tangram.</p> 	<p>Big or Small Collect several objects that are big and small. Put bowls in order by size, sort and stack rings, compare shoe sizes, sort items from nature or sort straws.</p> 	<p>What Goes Together Find objects around the house that go together (shoes and socks, toothbrush and toothpaste). Ask, 'how many can you find?'</p> 

<p>All About Me</p> <p>Search for a collection of objects that you like, put in a bag and tell a story to a family member.</p> 	<p>Obstacle Course</p> <p>Gather things you can use to climb over, tunnel under, pencil roll, balance, jump, skip through to make an obstacle course.</p> 	<p>Who Am I?</p> <p>Find old clothes that you can use to dress up in your favourite book or TV character and have our family guess who you are.</p> 	<p>Build a Cubby House</p> <p>Use old blankets, sheets, pillows and boxes to make a tent, tree house, castle, box house, reading corner for your teddy bear.</p> 	<p>Animal Moves</p> <p>Think of your favourite animals (frog, rabbit, bear, snake) and make a dance using animal movements and sounds.</p> 
<p>Art Gallery</p> <p>Use colours, lines, 2D shapes, textures, or nature make a range of artworks and display in the kitchen.</p> 	<p>Fun with Craft</p> <p>Find craft materials and make an Easter egg, ANZAC poster, card for Nana, collage shapes.</p> 	<p>What's the Weather?</p> <p>Pretend to be weather forecaster. Find different types of clothes you need for Summer, Autumn, Winter, Spring.</p> 	<p>Float or Sink?</p> <p>Show different ways you can experiment with water. Build a paper boat, explore objects that float/sink, explore items for pouring and collecting.</p> 	<p>My Concert</p> <p>Organise a concert: sing, role play and dress up to all your favourite nursery rhymes and favourite songs.</p> 
<p>I'm a Scientist</p> <p>Make some slime, playdough, bubbles, crystals, fizzing colours, magic milk and explore changes in properties.</p> 	<p>Twiggle the Turtle</p> <p>Draw pictures in magazines of happy, sad, angry, silly situation. Ask 'when you would feel like that and what would you do?'</p> 	<p>Lego Champion</p> <p>Collect lego pieces and make a house, airplane, tall tower, name or your superhero.</p> 	<p>Puppet Show</p> <p>Create a range of puppets (finger, hand, paper, felt, pop-stick) and retell your favourite story.</p> 	<p>Plant a Garden</p> <p>Make a miniature terrarium garden, fairy garden, insect, safari or beach scene.</p>
