It will be fantastic to see our garden area come alive again with the funds provided. Thank you.

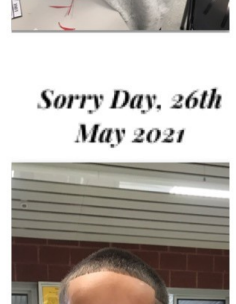
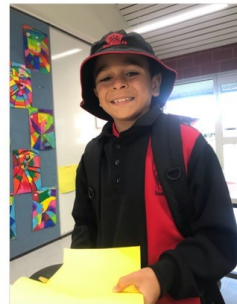
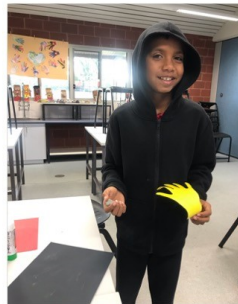
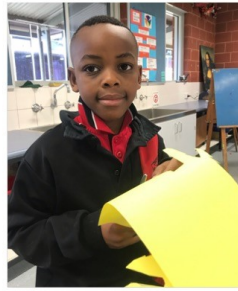
