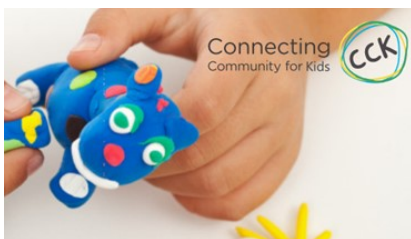
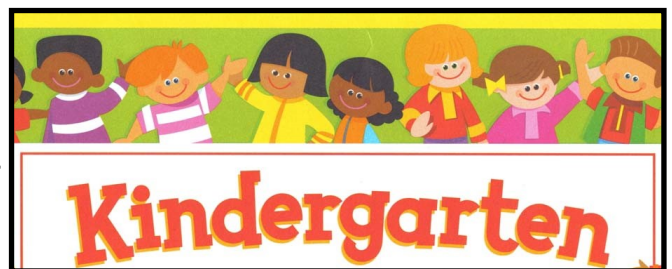
Kindergarten Enrolment & Orientation Morning
