



It's Time to Enrol For 2020

The first years of school are so important. It is a time when your child discovers the wonder and excitement of learning, exploring and imagining.

It is really important for you to be involved in your child's learning during these important years. Continuing the learning at home helps build their confidence at school and in life. All children from Pre-primary to Year 12 are guaranteed a place at their local public school.

We are now taking applications for enrolment.

You need to enrol for:

- **Kindergarten**—if your child turns four years old by 30 June 2020.
- **Pre-primary** —if your child turns five years old by 30 June 2020. (first year of compulsory school).

A Birth Certificate and a current Immunisation Record are required on enrolment.
