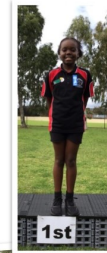
Southwell Cross Country Event

Interschool Cross Country

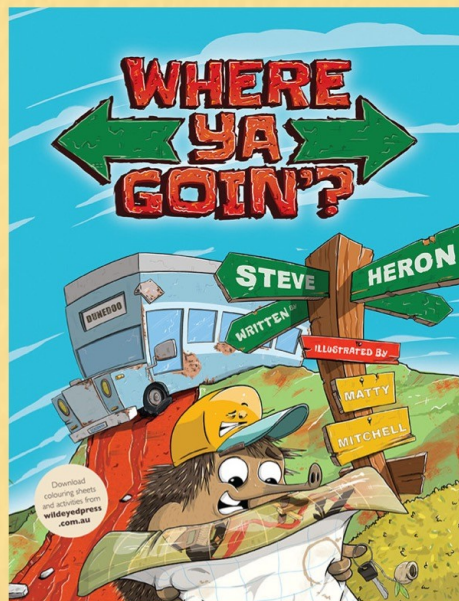
A big thank you to Amy Leeder for organising the interschool cross country event. The students all tried their best at this event and are to be commended on their behaviour.
